

COOKIE POLICY

Scope of This Policy

1. DRIFT Energy Limited (**we** or **us** or **our**) uses cookies when you visit our website, <https://drift.energy/>, (the **Website**) to help customise the Website and improve your experience using the Website.
2. This Policy applies between you, the user of this Website, and us, DRIFT Energy Limited, the owner and provider of this Website.
3. When you visit the Website, and before your Website places cookies on your computer, you will be presented with a message bar requesting your consent to set those cookies. By giving your consent to the placing of cookies, you are enabling us to provide a better experience and service. You may, if you wish, deny consent to the placing of these cookies; however, certain features of the Website may not function fully or as intended. This applies to the cookies that we set. One page of the Website — our careers page — embeds a film hosted by YouTube, which sets its own cookies when that page loads and before you have answered the message bar; those cookies are listed in the Cookie Schedule below.

What Are Cookies?

5. A cookie is a small text file placed on your computer by this Website when you visit certain parts of the Website and/or when you use certain features of the Website.
6. This Website may place and access certain cookies on your computer. We use these cookies to improve your experience of using the Website.
7. Cookies do not usually contain any information that personally identifies you, as the Website user. However, personal information that we store about you may be linked to the information obtained from and stored in cookies. Types of Cookies

8. This Website uses the following cookies:

Type of cookie	Purpose
Strictly necessary cookies	These are cookies that are required for the operation of the Website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of the Website, use a shopping cart or make use of e-billing services.
Analytical/performance cookies	These cookies allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our Website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our Website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
Functionality cookies	These are used to recognise you when you return to our Website. This enables us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region). By using the Website, you agree to our placement of functionality cookies.

10. We have carefully chosen these cookies and have taken steps to ensure that your privacy is protected and respected at all times.

How To Control Your Cookies

If you reject them, we will not ask you again on subsequent visits.

Cookies that we use on the Website:

Strictly Necessary Cookies

We use the following strictly necessary cookies:

Name	Purpose of cookie	Duration
drift.consent	Set by this Website. Records the answer you gave to the cookie message bar, and the date you gave it, so that we honour your choice and do not ask you again on every page. This is the only item we store regardless of your answer, including where you reject analytics cookies. It is never transmitted to us or to any third party and remains in your browser. Technically it is stored in your browser's local storage rather than as a cookie, and it is listed here for completeness.	Until you clear your browser storage

Analytical/Performance Cookies

We use the following analytical/performance cookies. **These are set only if you accept them.** Until you do, they do not exist on your device and no information about your visit is sent to our analytics provider.

Name	Purpose of cookie	Duration
_ga	Set by Google Analytics. Distinguishes one visitor from another by storing a randomly generated identifier, so that we can tell how many separate people have visited rather than how many visits there have been. It does not contain your name, email address or anything you have entered on the Website.	2 years
_ga_D504FBGP4Y	Set by Google Analytics. Keeps track of the current visit — when it began and whether it is still in progress — so that several pages read in succession are counted as one visit rather than several. The suffix identifies our specific analytics property.	2 years

Functionality Cookies

We use the following functionality cookies. These are set by YouTube on one page of the Website only — our careers page, which plays an embedded film. They are set when that page loads. If you do not visit that page, they are not set.

VISITOR_INFO1_LIVE	Set by YouTube on the youtube.com domain. Used by YouTube to estimate bandwidth and to remember player preferences, and as part of measuring and preventing abuse of its service.	180 days

VISITOR_PRIVACY_METADATA	Set by YouTube on the youtube.com domain. Stores the visitor's cookie consent state for the youtube.com domain.	180 days
YSC	Set by YouTube on the youtube.com domain. Registers a unique identifier for the browsing session, used by YouTube to count views of embedded videos.	Session — deleted when you close your browser
__Secure-YNID	Set by YouTube on the youtube.com domain. A security and preferences identifier used by Google.	180 days
__Secure-ROLLOUT_TOKEN	Set by YouTube on the youtube.com domain. Used by Google to control the staged rollout of changes to its player.	180 days
ytidb::LAST_RESULT_ENTRY_KEY yt-player-caption-persistence yt-icons-last-purged	Stored by the embedded player in your browser's local storage on the youtube-nocookie.com domain rather than as cookies. They hold the player's own interface state, including caption preferences.	Until you clear your browser storage

Third Party Content

One page of the Website — our careers page — plays a film hosted by YouTube. Every other image, film and typeface on the Website is served from our own servers. To play that film your browser contacts Google, which will therefore receive your IP address and the fact that you were on that page.

The player itself is configured to use Google's youtube-nocookie.com domain, but the player software is loaded from youtube.com, and it is that request which sets the cookies listed above. **This happens when the careers page loads, before and irrespective of any answer you give to the cookie message bar.** We would rather tell you this plainly than describe a protection that does not hold. The cookies and storage listed above were observed directly on 1 September 2026 in a clean browser with the film playing.
